Course	Description	Sessions
Advanced Biblical Studies (BIB300)	This module enables missional leaders to critically reflect on Scripture as a cross-cultural learning resource. There are numerous aspects of Scripture that have the people of God engaging in cross-cultural interaction. The key outcome for this module is to enable practitioners to use the bible as a tool to help them understand how the missionary God has enabled his people to engage in mission with other people groups.	24 one hour sessions over 12 weeks
Theology of missio Dei (TH300)	This advanced theology module enables students to understand the key theories about the missionary God's work alongside his people in their local mission contexts. A primary outcome of the course is that missional leaders are given the tools to understand how their missional community's identities are framed and informed by a particular picture of the missionary God. This module will help students to identify their community's picture of God, which will enable them to further form the identities of their communities through the lived out beliefs and practices of their people as they convey a picture of their God to their local non-Christian communities.	24 one hour sessions over 12 weeks
Missional Leadership (MMIN300)	Students are enabled to understand key effective theories about how senior missional leaders equip their communities to engage in God's mission. Moreover, it provides them with the critical understanding and approaches to help their missional communities to go through a change management process so that they may even more effectively reach new potential converts to the Christian faith.	24 one hour sessions over 12 weeks
The Missional Youth Leader (YTH300)	Students are enabled to understand key effective theories about how missional youth leaders equip their communities to engage in God's mission. Moreover, it provides them with the critical understanding and approaches to help their missional communities to go through a change management process so that they may even more effectively reach new potential converts to the Christian faith.	24 one hour sessions over 2 x 2 day residential intensives*
